# The UK's most comprehensive digital set of historical maps


Landmark's digital archive is the UK's largest and most comprehensive comprising over 1 million historical maps, covering England, Wales and Scotland. The historical maps give a complete step by step picture of land use changes that have occurred between the 1840's and the present day.

Each map is site centred for ease of comparison and overlaid with the current National Grid so that historical features can be accurately identified and transferred to modern mapping.

## 1:2500 and 1:10,000 Historical Maps

County Series maps are the earliest maps produced by the Ordnance Survey and each one covers an individual county, yet does not provide coverage for adjoining counties.

Some maps may appear unfinished, with all military camps and other strategic sites removed.



## Historical Building Plans

Historical Building Plans dating between 1886 and 1970 are now available digitally for the first time. Ideal for identifying previous occupants of buildings and past land uses, with very detailed information including; building materials, industrial building uses, on-site tanks, engines, stores and asbestos.
